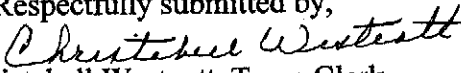
The 2008 organizational meeting was discussed It will be adopted at the January 2008 meeting.

After the minutes of the October 12, 2007 meeting were reviewed, Councilman Costello made the motion to accept these minutes as presented. Seconded by Councilman Coe. All voted in favor and motion carried.

Announcements:

Madison Co. Public Hearing 2008 Budget, November 20, 2008 at 9:20 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.

At this time Richard Elliott gave a report on the Erieville Water project. For possible funding there is the NYS Drinking Water State Revolving Fund which could be for a 20 to 20 year period at 3 ½ % interest and the rural Development fund for 38 years. Erieville's score is 185 and the funding limit line this year is 185. Dick Elliott said that Erieville has a good chance of getting funding. The plans, specs, the survey and date and the new well should be ready to submit to the county Health Dept. in Dec., 2007. By Feb. or March 2008, should be able to go out for bids for the new tank and the improvements to the system. Bill Magee and Dave Veleski may be able to help with the funding. Dick Elliott said that his fee through the bidding would be \$40,000.00

Reports:

Supervisor Summary of Expenditures

Supervisor Williams said that there had been some minor changes to the 2008 town budget in the Special District's. The sales tax went from \$251,396.27 to \$258,425.38 so the tax rate would be \$2.53 per \$1000.00. He went over the rest of the district's. After discussion, Councilman Costello made the motion to accept the 2008 budget as amended. Seconded by Councilman Coe. All voted in favor and motion carried.

Highway Report:

Jack said that the fire alarm is in full operation. The equipment is in winter mode. Sand is in place and the summer work is pretty well caught up. The floor is done in the addition.

Correspondence:

A copy of the first draft of the US Route 20 Corridor development plan for the Village and Town of Cazenovia.

From NIMYR for adjustments rates that only effect Law enforcement.

A letter from Roger Bradstreet, his interest in the judge position. Roger has a residency conflict.

A letter of resignation dated September 29, 2007 was received from Judge Penoyer at the last meeting. The motion to accept this resignation was made by Supervisor Williams and seconded by Councilman Cunningham. All voted in favor and motion carried. Discussion that Judge O'Sullivan thinks that he can handle the work load with an extra clerk. The Board will go from a month to month basis to see how it goes. Supervisor Williams will talk to Judge O'Sullivan.

NIMYR did an inspection of the Town Office Building, the Highway Garage and the play ground in Erieville. They said that there should be a shock absorbing material under the play equipment.

Old Business:

There was not any old business at this time.

New Business:

Supervisor Williams said that he has spoke with a new auditor - Dermody, Burke and Brown. Brenda works for them but, she never showed up on the Oct. 18, 2007 to audit the Tax Collector. So someone from that office will get back to Dick tomorrow.

Nothing new on Time Warner.

A letter from CACDA if we are interested to have a joint grant with the Town of Cazenovia to develop Ag. Protection Regulation's for land. Councilman Cunningham was representing the Town for CACDA but, as she has other commitments it was suggested that Tom Clarke be asked to represent the Town.

Comprehensive Plan:

The Town needs to be designated as Lead Agency for the SEQR. Supervisor Williams made the motion to have the Tow of Nelson as Lead Agency for SEQR. Seconded by Councilman Coe. All voted in favor and motion carried.

Jane Rice has the final draft of the Comprehensive Plan ready to send to the Madison Conty Planning Dept. for their review. The motion wa made by Councilman cunningham to send the final draft to the Co. Seconded by Supervisor Williams. All fvoted in favor and motion carried.

There is a formal meeting in Albany on November 14, 2007 for the reevised open burning law. The proposed ne law states that there will be no oopen buring for residential, barbeques, no burning wast crops for farmers. Garbage and toxic items are not to be burned.

December meeting will be held on the 20th.

Supervisor Williams gradulated Robert Davies and Denise Earl as newly elected Board Members starting January 1, 2008.

She has requested that there be no reception or ceremony because of her health. A plaque will be given to her by the committee.

Reports:

Supervisor report and Summary of Expenditures and Monthly Statement of Supervisor.

The preliminary budget for 2008 was presented to the Supervisor. The tax rate will go from \$2.49 in 2007 to \$2.58 for 2008. This is a 3.6% increase. The approximate General Fund is \$193,205.00 and the Highway Fund is \$730,125.80. There is a 3% raise for elected and appointed employee's and a 4% increase for personal services for the highway. Count Clerk was increased to \$6,000.00 as the Judge's want to have someone five days a week for two hours a day to take care of paperwork and answer the phone. Legal fees went up to \$5,000.00. Mortgage Tax was increased. \$40,000.00 for highway equipment.

Discussion of the revisions of the comprehensive plan.

Madison County:

Board meeting was October 9, 2007.

Public Hearings on the Budget is Nov. 20, 2007 at 9:20 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.

Town Clerk:

Chris said that because of hunting licenses Sept. Was a better month.

Planning Bard met Tuesday, with three members present. The reviewed two site plans and a special permit. ZBA meets on Monday, Oct. 29 at 7:30 p.m.

Highway Report:

The pipe has been replaced on Green Rd. The ditching is done on Chaphe Hill Rd. One mile of Old State Rd. competed. Sanderson Rd. Has been double coated. Did .3 miles of Walrath Rd. A total of 5.1 miles of road has be resurfaced.

The traffic count for Lyon Rd. Was 349 daily and n. Lake Rd. Was 379 daily.

Fire Alarm system is activated.

Jack submitted a list of roads or portion of roads that he would like to have designated as "seasonal limited use highway" by Section 205-a of the Highway Law for the winter season of 2007-2008. After discussion Supervisor Williams made the motion to allow these roads to be seasonal limited. Seconded by Councilman Coe. All voted in favor and motion carried. Jack will check into Peterson Hollow and Stony Pond road's.

Old Business:

A letter from David Penoyer dated Sept. 29, 2007 that he is resigning as Judge and his last day will be Oct. 30, 2007. He and his wife are moving out of the area. He has been a Judge for 30 years.

Tom Tait, Chairman of the Caz. Recreation Committee would like the Town of Nelson to pay \$1,000.00 to enforce access to the boat launch at Lakeside Park. Now only residents of the school district can use the boat launch with purchase of a permit which, very few do this. Village Police chief said that they do not have time to enforce this law. This would entitle the Town of Nelson residents to use this access. After discussion the Board decided not to go with this request.

Youth baseball was discussed. The Board said that the two ballfields could be used at anytime that was needed by the baseball teams. The idea of making another field on the Nelson field was discussed.

Supervisor Williams said that he has gotten a quote for a new PC for the Town Clerk in the amount of \$979.00. He asked if the Board would approve a \$300.00 dock for his laptop PC. After discussion Councilman Costello made the motion to approve the purchase of the PC for the Clerk and the dock for the Supervisor. Seconded by Councilman Coe. All voted in favor and motion carried.

Denise Earl said that the sign on Marris Rd. is missing. Jack said several signs are missing and that he has ordered them and waiting for them to come in so that he can get them installed.

Town Clerk reported that 50 dogs had been licensed for August.. Planning Board approved a subdivision and Site Plan at their meeting on Sept. 11, 2007. ZBA will meet Tuesday, Oct. 18, 2007 at 7:30 p.m.

Highway Report:

Jack reported that the section of Old State Rd. under the CHIPS has been paved and the driveways are done. Sanderson Rd. has been stoned and oiled and a couple of driveways have to be matched. County catch basin on Chaphe Hill Rd. Is not right so the County will correct this. Davis Hill Rd. has mud in the road. Jack said that they have done some work on the turn around and that is probably where the mud is from.

Madison County Driveway Assoc. has a proposed policy for placing pipe under driveways. Jack said that the Owner furnishes the pipe and the highway puts it in. He also said that he thinks that any new subdivision that needs a driveway should be look at by the Highway Superintendent.

Nothing on the fire alarm system. No response from the Representative.

After discussion of the County sand bids Jack said that it would be cheaper to get the sand from Zupan. From Marshall's trucking it for 32 miles would be \$100.80. Trucking from Zupan's at 15 miles would be \$92.00. This is per load. The motion was made by Councilman Coe to get the sand from Zupan. Seconded by Supervisor Williams. All voted in favor and motion carried. Councilman Costello abstained his vote.

Purchasing stone dust was discussed. From Kinsilla would be \$10.29 and delivered \$10.59. It was decided not to use it as it is light in color and people does not think that there is sand on the road. Jack also thinks that sand does a better job with ice.

Next monthly meeting will be October 11, 2007.

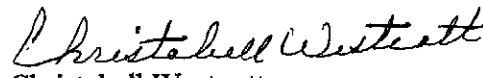

At this time Lillian Felix, Sec. of the Erieville Water District, told the Board that Harry Griffiths (owns Erieville Post Office) does not know why he should pay the minimum charge of \$25.00 for 8000 gals. of water used when only 1000 gals were used. 1000 gals of water have been used for two billing periods. He also claims that the water meter is not being read. The Board will address this problem with a letter to Mr. Griffiths.

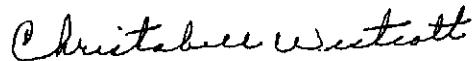
